1. History of the Institute:

The National Institute of Technology Goa (NIT Goa) is a premier national-level technical institute in India established in 2010 by an act of parliament (NIT Act, 2007 and NIT (Amendment) Act, 2012). NIT Goa is an autonomous institute functioning under the aegis of Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India, and has been declared an “Institute of National Importance”. The NIT Goa campus is located in the Kottamoll plateau, Cuncolim, Salcete Goa 403 703, approximately 50 km south of Panaji, the capital of Goa. Goa is well connected by roadways, railways and airways with various parts of the country. The Institute is dedicated to its academic excellence and aims to produce quality Engineers and Scientists.

1.1 Function and Duties of the Institute:

The Institute offers undergraduate programmes in Five Engineering Departments: (1) Computer Science and Engineering (CSE), (2) Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE), (3) Electrical and Electronics Engineering (EEE), (4) Civil Engineering (CVE), and (5) Mechanical Engineering (MCE). The Institute offers M.Tech. Programmes in the Three disciplines: (1) Computer Science and Engineering (CSE), (2) VLSI and (3) Power Electronics and Power Systems (PEPS). The Institute also offers Ph.D. degree in various stream of Engineering, Applied Sciences, Technology and Humanities & Social Sciences

The Institute admits students into the B.Tech. degree programme based on the ranks obtained in the Joint Entrance Examination JEE (Main) and the scheme of Direct Admission to Students Abroad (DASA). Intake of B.Tech. in Computer Science and Engineering/Electrical and Electronics Engineering/ Electronics and Communication Engineering is 58 each, out of which 50 is through JoSAA/CSAB and 08 through DASA; and the Intake of B.Tech. in Civil Engineering/Mechanical Engineering is 42 each, out of which 37 is through JoSAA/CSAB and 05 through DASA. Therefore, total intake of First-Year B.Tech at NIT Goa is 258, out of which 224 students have been admitted through JoSAA / CSAB and 34 through DASA. The Institute admits M.Tech. students through valid GATE score followed by CCMT (Centralized Counselling for M.Tech. Admissions), and few seats are offered to the sponsored and DRDO candidates. Intake of M.Tech. CSE and ECE is 27 (23 through CCMT, 04 sponsored/DRDO) each, and the intake of M.Tech. EEE is 26 (22 through CCMT, 04 sponsored/DRDO). The overall intake of M.Tech. is 80. NIT Goa also offers Full-time Self-Financed (Non-GATE) M.Tech. in those seats which remain vacant after admission through CCMT, sponsored, and DRDO categories is completed. Presently there are one boys' hostels and one girls' hostel in the new campus. Each hostel provides basic furniture, Wi-Fi/LAN-enabled internet and Mess facilities. The Institute is well-equipped with laboratories, workshops and has an up-to-date Library with rich and comprehensively high-quality print and electronic resources. The Training and Placement Cell of National Institute of Technology Goa is committed to providing students with excellent career opportunities across a wide range of industries. Every year, several reputed organizations visit the institute's transit campus for recruitment in domains such as Research & Development, Engineering & Technology, IT and Software Development, Analytics, Finance, Education, Consulting, and Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs). This year, the institute witnessed a significant rise in the number of internship opportunities accompanied by Pre-Placement Offers (PPOs) extended to pre-final year students.

NIT Goa signed many MoUs and Agreements with other academic & research institutes, industries and organizations to facilitate faculty and student exchange programs, knowledge sharing, carrying-out interdisciplinary research works, joint research guidance, curriculum and course developments, joint workshop, conferences, seminars, and many more student and faculty development programs.

All the faculty members of NIT Goa are dedicated to training the students with a world-class education. Faculty members are actively involved in research works and have executed many funded R & D projects. They have been publishing research articles and book chapters regularly. Many faculty members have been granted and many have filed patent/patents. Institute has organised several GIAN, STTP, FDP, Workshops, National and International Conferences etc. The Institute also organises outreach activities/initiatives like 'Rashtriya Aavishkar Abhiyan (RAA)', 'Unnat Bharat Abhiyan', 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan', 'Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat', 'FiT India' programmes, and many more.

The students of NIT Goa are actively involved in various co-curricular activities through students' clubs, councils, and study circles like SPECTRA, TESLA, QUANTA, CESCO & META etc. The SPIE and IEEE student chapters of the Institute organise various scientific and research-oriented events. The annual techno-cultural fest of NIT Goa is SAAVYAS. For overall development of the students, the institute also provides sports facilities. In 2018, NIT Goa organised All India Inter NIT Faculty and Staff Tournament. The students also celebrate cultural festivals of different states of India to maintain unity in diversity and it is a collective effort by the institute to inculcate integral education of mind and body. NIT Goa is currently functioning on its permanent campus at Cuncolim, South Goa since 08/01/2024.

Academic History

National Institute of Technology Goa (NIT Goa) is a premier technical Institute of the region. NIT Goa was established in the year 2010 by an act of parliament (NIT act 2007) and it is declared as '**Institute of National Importance**'. NIT Goa is an autonomous institute and functioning under the aegis of Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Govt. of India. NIT GOA is one of the ten newly set up NITs during the 11th Five Year Plan by the Ministry of Human Resources Development (MHRD). The institute was to be set up using Rs. 250 crore provided by central government. The first batch of students was admitted in 2010 and academic activities of NIT Goa started in the academic year 2010-11.

NIT Goa started functioning in 2010 with three Engineering Departments: (1) Computer Science and Engineering (2) Electronics and Communication Engineering and (3) Electrical and Electronics Engineering at undergraduate level. NIT Goa attracts students from all over the country and abroad. The Institute admits students to B. Tech Degree program on the basis of ranks obtained in the Joint Entrance Examination (JEE main) and the scheme of Direct Admission of Students Abroad (DASA). Forty percent of the seats are reserved for the students of Goa, Ten percent Diu Daman, Dadra Nagar Haveli & Lakshadweep and the remaining seats are based on the all India rank. The institute also admits students to M.Tech and Ph.D. Degree

Programs. The institute is sincerely attempting to deliver quality education and to achieve excellence in teaching, learning and research with high professional ethics.

Structure of B.Tech. Programme

The medium of instruction, examination and project reports are in English.

Undergraduate B.Tech Degree programmes are offered by the departments (i) to (v) and all the below-listed departments offer courses in the B.Tech Programme.

- i. Computer Science and Engineering (CSE)
- ii. Electrical and Electronics Engineering (EEE)
- iii. Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE)
- iv. Mechanical Engineering (MCE)
- v. Civil Engineering (CVE)
- vi. Department of Applied Sciences (APS), covering areas such as:
 - a. Mathematics (MA)
 - b. Physics (PH)
 - c. Chemistry (CY)
- vii. Department of Humanities and Social Sciences (HSS), covering areas such as:
 - a. Economics (HS)
 - b. English (HU)

In addition, the departments also offer courses under the mandatory learning category, Indian knowledge systems and others. The programme structure consists of the following:

- i. A general (common) core programme comprising of basic sciences, basic engineering sciences and technical arts, humanities and social sciences, Indian knowledge systems.
- ii. Department core courses introducing the student to the foundations of engineering in the respective branch;
- iii. Department elective courses enabling the student to opt and undergo a set of courses of interest;
- iv. Open elective courses enabling the student to opt and undergo a set of courses of interest from other departments for nurturing interdisciplinary interest;
- v. Professional practice including project, Comprehensive Viva-Voce and industrial training/summer internship (for 6-8 weeks) and,
- vi. Courses on Environmental Studies, Physical Education, Professional Ethics and Human Values, Liberal Arts, Innovation & Entrepreneurship.

Every branch of the B.Tech. programme have a curriculum and syllabi for the courses approved by the Senate. Every department has a prescribed course structure which in general terms is known as Curriculum or Course of Study. It prescribes courses to be studied in each semester. The courses of study bulletin are available in the Institute's website.

The Institute follows a credit-based semester system. There are two regular semesters in a year. The semester normally that begins in July/August (*July/August to December*) is known as 'ODD' semester and the semester that begins in January (*January to May*) is known as 'EVEN' semester. The complete programme will consist of 9 classifications, as given in Table 1. namely- basic sciences, basic engineering sciences and technical arts, humanities and social sciences, Indian knowledge systems, department theory & practice, and Others, distributed over eight semesters with two semesters per academic year. Department Core courses

commence from the third semester. The elective courses normally be offered from the sixth semester. However, the departmental board of studies decide the final course structure.

The academic programmes of the Institute follow the credit system. The general pattern is one credit for each lecture hour per week per semester; two credits for each laboratory/practical session of three hours per week per semester, one credit for each laboratory/practical session of two hours per week per semester and one credit for each laboratory/practical session of three hours per week per half semester. However, there can be a few special courses with a slight variation in credit allotment.

The curriculum of any branch of the B. Tech. programme shall have a total of a minimum 168 credits. Every course of the B.Tech. programme will be placed in one of the classifications listed in Table 1. The minimum credits to be earned for the award of B.Tech. degree is 168.

The courses - Physical Education, Environmental Studies, Professional Ethics and Human Values are of Pass/Fail (i.e., non-credit) category which will not be included in the computation of SGPA/CGPA. They are graded either Satisfactory (SA) or Unsatisfactory (US). However, satisfactory completion of these courses is mandatory for degree completion.

Departmental courses (DC and DE) constitute atleast 60% of the total curriculum. Further, students are allowed open electives (OE) to broaden their inter-disciplinary knowledge base and to specialize in an area outside the parent discipline.

As part of the implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP-2020), the Institute has introduced Minors in various disciplines.

Structure of M.Tech Programme

- ❖ The medium of instruction, examination and project reports will be English.
- ❖ Postgraduate (M.Tech Degree) programmes are offered in the following disciplines by the respective programme hosting Departments.
 - Master of Technology in “Computer Science and Engineering” (M.Tech. (CSE)) by the Department of Computer Science and Engineering (CSE)
 - Master of Technology in “VLSI” (M.Tech. (VLSI)) by the Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE).
 - Master of Technology in “Power Electronics and Power Systems”(M. Tech. (PEPS))by the Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering (EEE). Other teaching Department, Humanities and Sciences (HS) shall offer courses for these three different programmes.
- ❖ Each programme of instruction consists of the following:
 - An engineering “Programme Core” introducing the student to the state of the art in engineering in the respective branch.
 - A “Programme Elective” enabling the student to opt and undergo a set of specialized courses;
 - A “Professional practice” which includes independent study, seminar, comprehensive-viva, technical communication, etc.
 - A Dissertation work on specialized advanced engineering and/or research work of state of art nature.
- ❖ Each of the postgraduate programmes will have a curriculum and syllabi for the courses approved by the Senate. Every department has a prescribed course structure which in general terms is known as “Curriculum” or “Courses of Study”. It prescribes courses to be studied in the programme in each of the semesters as well as credits earned. The courses of study bulletin are available in the Institute’s website.
- ❖ The Institute follows a credit based semester system. There are two regular semesters in a year. The semester that begins in July (July to December) is known as „ODD “Semester and the semester that begins in January (January to June) is known as „EVEN“ Semester. The general pattern is: One credit for each lecture hour per week per semester; Two credits for each laboratory course of three to four hours per week per semester.
- ❖ The complete programme will consist of 4 categories (as given in the Table 1): Core, Electives, Dissertation work and Professional Practices distributed over four semesters with two semesters per academic year.

- ❖ The curriculum of any branch of the M. Tech. programmes shall have a total of minimum 64 credits. Minimum credits for each of the categories are specified in the Table below, which has to be earned by students for the award of M.Tech. degree.

Every course of the M. Tech. programme will be placed in one of the 4 categories as listed in Table.

1.3.2 Related provision and act: The Institute has a Director, Six Deans, a Registrar and Heads of the Departments/section, who carry out the various functions of the Institute as per procedures laid down in the statutes of the Institute. The decision is communicated to the public by notices, announcements, website and advertisements. The final authority to vet the final decision is the Director / Board of Governors / Council for NITs/ Visitor of the Institute. The Institute decides students' affairs, faculty & staff affairs, facilities of the Institute and its infrastructure.

1.3.3 Final Decision-making authority: The Institute has a Director, Six Deans, a Registrar and Heads of the Departments/section, who carry out the various functions of the Institute as per procedures laid down in the Statues of the Institute. The decision is communicated to public by notices, announcements, website and advertisements. The final authority to vet the final decision is the Director / Board of Governors / Council for NITs. The Institute takes decision regarding students' affairs, faculty & staff affairs, facilities of the Institute and its infrastructure.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs) ON RTI

Q.1. What is Information?

Information is any material in any form. It includes records, documents, memos, e-mails, opinions, advices, press releases, circulars, orders, logbooks, contracts, reports, papers, samples, models, data material held in any electronic form. It also includes information relating to any private body which can be accessed by the public authority under any law for the time being in force.

Q.2. What is a Public Authority?

A "public authority" is any authority or body or institution of self government established or constituted by or under the Constitution; or by any other law made by the Parliament or a State Legislature; or by notification issued or order made by the Central Government or a State Government. The bodies owned, controlled or substantially financed by the Central Government or a State Government and non-Government organisations substantially financed by the Central Government or a State Government also fall within the definition of public authority. The financing of the body or the NGO by the Government may be direct or indirect.

Q.3 What is a Public Information Officer?

Public authorities have designated some of its officers as Public Information Officer. They are responsible to give information to a person who seeks information under the RTI Act.

Q.4. What is the Fee for Seeking Information from Central Government Public Authorities?

A person who desires to seek some information from a Central Government Public Authority is required to send, along with the application, a demand draft or a banker's cheque or an Indian Postal Order of Rs.10/- (Rupees ten), payable to the Accounts Officer of the public authority as fee prescribed for seeking information. The payment of fee can also be made by way of cash to the Accounts Officer of the public authority or to the Assistant Public Information Officer against proper receipt. However, the RTI Fee and the mode of payment may vary as under Section 27 and Section 28, of the RTI Act, 2005 the appropriate Government and the competent authority, respectively, by notification in the Official Gazette, make rules to carry out the provisions of this Act.

Q.5. What is the Fee for the BPL applicant for Seeking Information?

If the applicant belongs to below poverty line (BPL) category, he is not required to pay any fee. However, he should submit a proof in support of his claim to belong to the below poverty line.

Q.6. Is there any specific Format of Application?

There is no prescribed format of application for seeking information. The application can be made on plain paper. The application should, however, have the name and complete postal address of the applicant.

Q.7. Is it required to give any reason for seeking information?

The information seeker is not required to give reasons for seeking information.

Q.8. Is there any provision for exemption from Disclosure of Information?

Sub-section (1) of section 8 and section 9 of the Act enumerate the types of information which is exempt from disclosure. Sub-section (2) of section 8, however, provides that information exempted under sub-section 3 (1) or exempted under the Official Secrets Act, 1923 can be disclosed if public interest in disclosure overweighs the harm to the protected interest.

Q.9. Is there any assistance available to the Applicant for filing RTI application?

If a person is unable to make a request in writing, he may seek the help of the Public Information Officer to write his application and the Public Information Officer should render him reasonable assistance. Where a decision is taken to give access to a sensorily disabled person to any document, the Public Information Officer, shall provide such assistance to the person as may be appropriate for inspection.

Q.10. What is the Time Period for Supply of Information?

In normal course, information to an applicant shall be supplied within 30 days from the receipt of application by the public authority. If information sought concerns the life or liberty of a person, it shall be supplied within 48 hours. In case the application is sent through the Assistant Public Information Officer or it is sent to a wrong public authority, five days shall be added to the period of thirty days or 48 hours, as the case may be.

Q.11. Is there any provision of Appeal under the RTI Act?

If an applicant is not supplied information within the prescribed time of thirty days or 48 hours, as the case may be, or is not satisfied with the information furnished to him, he may prefer an appeal to the first appellate authority who is an officer senior in rank to the Public Information Officer. Such an appeal, should be filed within a period of thirty days from the date on which the limit of 30 days of supply of information is expired or from the date on which the information or decision of the Public Information Officer is received. The appellate authority of the public authority shall dispose of the appeal within a period of thirty days or in exceptional cases within 45 days of the receipt of the appeal.

Q.12. Is there any scope for second appeal under the RTI Act?

If the first appellate authority fails to pass an order on the appeal within the prescribed period or if the appellant is not satisfied with the order of the first appellate authority, he may prefer a second appeal with the Central Information Commission within ninety days from the date on which the decision should have been made by the first appellate authority or was actually received by the appellant.

Q.13. Whether Complaints can be made under this Act? If yes, under what conditions?

If any person is unable to submit a request to a Public Information Officer either by reason that such an officer has not been appointed by the concerned public authority; or the Public Information Officer has refused to accept his or her application or appeal for forwarding the same to the appellate authority, as the case may be; or he has been refused access to any information requested by him under the RTI Act; or he has not been given a response to a request for information within the time limit specified in the Act; or he has been required to

pay an amount of fee which he considers unreasonable; or he believes that he has been given incomplete, misleading or false information, he can make a complaint to the Information Commission.

Q.14. What is Third Party Information?

Third party in relation to the Act means a person other than the citizen who has made request for information. The definition of third party includes a public authority other than the public authority to whom the request has been made.

Q.15. What is the Method of Seeking Information?

A citizen who desires to obtain any information under the Act, should make an application to the Public Information Officer of the concerned public authority in writing in English or Hindi or in the official language of the area in which the application is made. The application should be precise and specific. He should make payment of application fee at the time of submitting the application as prescribed in the Fee Rules.

Q.16. Is there any organization(s) exempt from providing information under RTI Act?

Yes, certain intelligence and security organisations specified in the Second Schedule, are exempted from providing information excepting the information pertaining to the allegations of corruption and human rights violations. Courtesy – Guide on Right to Information Act, 2005 issued by the department of personnel and training Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pension Government of India.

Q. 17. Will I be informed about the additional fee (if any) is required to pay?

In case additional fee representing the cost is required for providing information, the CPIO will intimate the same, which can be viewed by the applicant through "View Status" option in the RTI Online Portal and an e-mail alert or SMS or both will also be sent to the applicant for the same.

For payment of additional fee online, the applicant needs to use the option 'View Status' in the RTI Online Portal and on providing the registration number of the request, option for "Make Payment" will be available.

Q. 18. How do I file an appeal with First Appellate Authority?

For making an appeal to the first Appellate Authority, the applicant has to select the option "Submit First Appeal" in the RTI Online Portal and fill up the form that will appear. The registration number and e-mail ID of the original application is required for filing the first appeal.

Q. 19. Is it mandatory to create user account on RTI online web portal?

No. You can directly file your RTI on "Submit Request" tab.

Q. 20 What should I do if amount is deducted from my account but registration number is not generated?

Please do not attempt to make payment repeatedly or try to submit request once again. Kindly wait for the 24 to 48 working hours as registration number will be generated after

reconciliation. If it is not generated within stipulated time frame then kindly send an e-mail at [help@rtionline-dopt\[at\]nic\[dot\]in](mailto:help@rtionline-dopt.nic.in) with your transaction details.

Q. 21 What should I do when portal is not allowing me to file the first appeal?

This may happen under following two situation:

- 1) When your RTI application has been physically transferred to other public authority, which is not aligned to this portal. In such a case, you are required to file your appeal in physical mode to the concerned public authority.
- 2) Another case can be if your RTI application has not been replied to by CPIO and 30 days period has not lapsed. In such a case, you may file first appeal only after completion of stipulated time period of 30 days.

Q 22. How to upload a supporting document if an alert comes as "SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FROM APPLICANT"?

When a Public Authority request for supporting document, an alert is sent to the applicant to his/her Mobile or Email Id. In such situation, the applicant is requested to visit the RTI Online Website and enter the details in 'View Status'. Once the detail is entered, the current status of the RTI application is shown along with the option for uploading the supporting document.

Q 23. Can I file RTI application for state public authorities through this portal?

No. This Portal is exclusively meant for Public Authorities under Central Govt. only.

1.	Even after the lapse of more than thirty years of the implementation of the reservation policy for OBCs, it has been found that there is very little representation of OBCs in top management of government, government-aided organizations and educational institutions. What measures can be undertaken by DoPT to ensure fair representation of OBCs in all such organizations and PSUs?	The NIT Goa has a sanctioned strength of 134 posts (62 faculty and 72 non-faculty posts) including the promotion quota. A total of 15 faculty posts were earmarked for OBC, out of which 07 OBC faculty are in position. As per the roster, the remaining OBC positions are notified and recruitment process is in progress. A total of 08 non-faculty posts were earmarked for OBC, out of which 04 OBC non-faculty are in position. As per the roster, the remaining OBC positions are notified and recruitment process is in progress.
3.	Since the implement of the OBC reservation policy in September 1993, it has continuously been noticed that the OBCs are underreported in one or the other government, government-aided organizations and educational institutions even after the various ways and means been undertaken by the DoPT with regard to implementation of the OBC reservation. What are the constraints and ways out for ensuring	It is submitted that the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Teachers' Cadre) Act, 2019, was brought out vide Gazette Notification dt.09.07.2019 applying reservation for all cadres of faculty in NITs. The Institute has been endeavoring to bring the shortfall OBC faculty positions at the earliest by recruiting the vacant positions. For the non-academic posts, the Institute has

4	The Committee have been pursuing the issues of OBCs through the channel of OBC Reservation cells and OBC welfare associations, wherever they exist in the government, government-aided organizations and educational institutions. However, the Committee find that due to lack of proper directions/ guidelines issued by the DoPT for formation of OBC welfare association. The Institute follows the reservation norms as prescribed by the Government of India.
5	In view of the recent trend of the government to focus more on entrepreneurship, outsourcing of services and constructional appointments in government, government-aided organizations and educational institutions, what measures could be undertaken to safeguard the interest of OBC through the instrument of OBC reservation policy?	The government, government-aided organizations and educational institutions can follow the reservation norms as prescribed by the Government of India while appointing in outsourcing of services and constructional appointments.
6	What mechanism could be put in place for assessment of the ceiling for determining the creamy layer among the OBC category on the lapse of a fixed interval of time, considering the inflationary and other factors of income? What are the parameters and who are the stakeholders and other interest groups being considered for determining the ceiling limit of the creamy layers among OBC category?	-----
7	The Committee have be receiving numerous representations from aggrieved OBC candidates who have been denied joining of government services by being categorized under creamy layer. The DoPT have cited reasons for such occurrences that equivalence of posts in Central and State Autonomous bodies, statutory organizations and government-aided institutions, etc. is yet to be established. What is the reason for the issue of equivalence not being addressed even after the lapse of more than thirty years of implementation of the OBC reservation as a large number of OBC candidates have suffered due to this?	The Institute follows the reservation norms as prescribed by the Government of India.
8.	What measures can be undertaken in order to	The Institute has been filling the vacant OBC
