

FAQ for Faculty applicants

Q 1. Where is NIT Goa located?

Ans: NIT Goa is an Institute of national importance, located at Farmagudi which is about 4 kms from Ponda, Goa and 29 k.m. south-east of Panjim and about 25 kms from Margao. Farmagudi is well-connected by road with various parts of Goa, and also with the Dabolim airport.

Q 2. How to reach NIT Goa?

Ans: Pre-paid cabs are available from the airport to reach Farmagudi. Pre-paid cabs at airport cost about Rs.700/ to reach NIT. There are regular bus services between Panjim, Margao, Dabolim Airport and, the Margao railway station to Ponda.

Q 3. How is the climate of Goa?

Ans: The climate of Goa is pleasant as it is a coastal state. The day temperature ranges between 25-30°C and the night temperatures between 22°C to 25°C. The winter is cool but not chilly. Goa enjoys a prolonged monsoon that starts around the middle of June and continues till the end of September. But in Goa, monsoon is enjoyable; moreover, Ponda has the hills and the natural forest. Ponda is famous for its famous temples and heritage places.

Q 4. Details of Faculty members and research?

Ans: The faculty members of NIT, Goa are highly qualified, experienced in their respective fields. They endeavour to impart quality education to the students in terms of innovation in science and technology.
